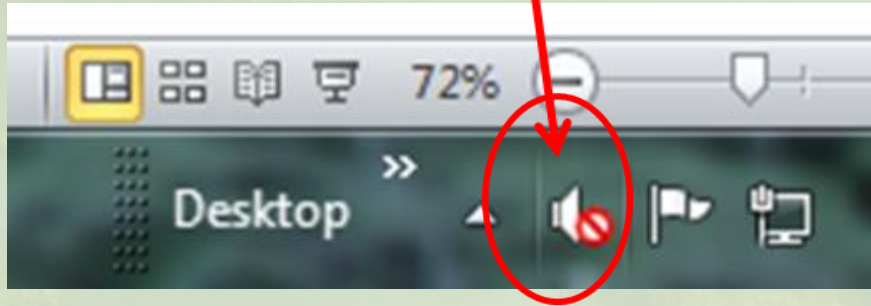

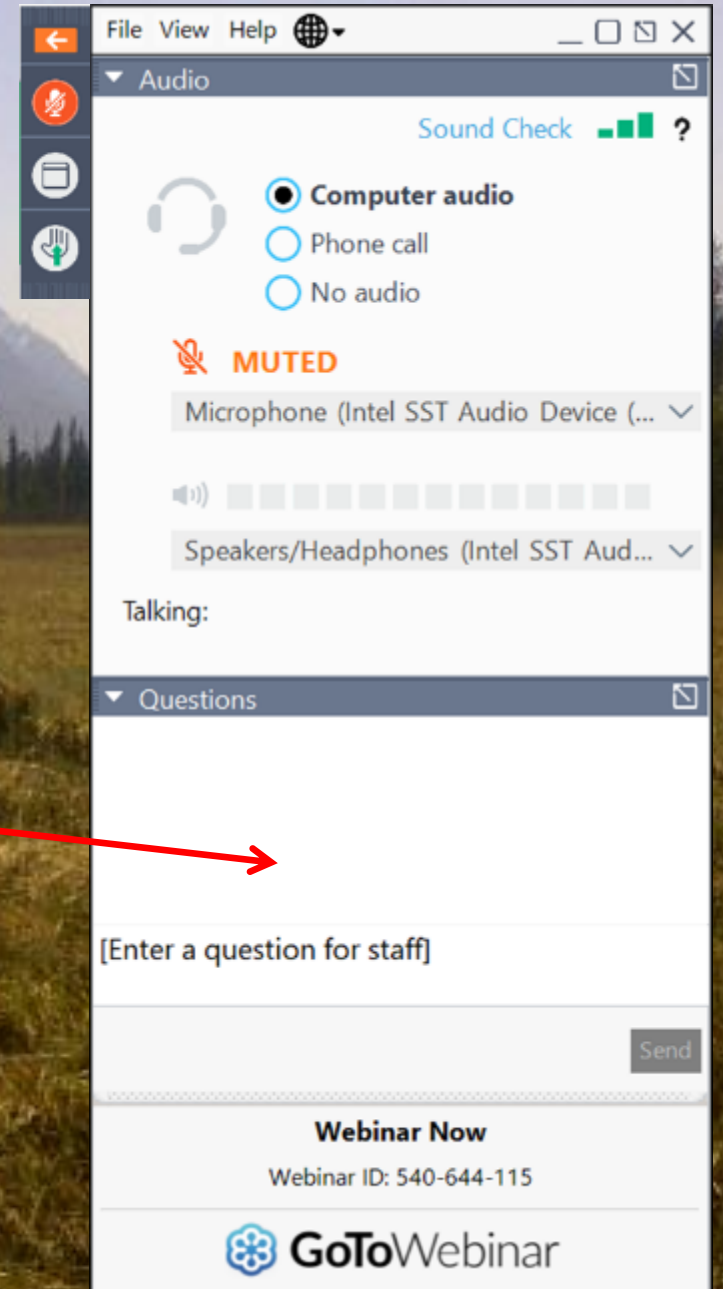

Webinar Overview

In 2020 the EPA narrowed the definition of 'Waters of the United States', significantly limiting wetland protection under the Clean Water Act. Current policy debates center on the uncertainty around wetland benefits. This webinar will explore the findings of a recently published paper where the authors estimate the value of wetlands for flood mitigation across the U.S. using detailed flood claims and land use data.

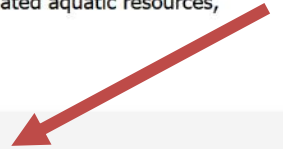
