

Fond du Lac Reservation:

- Located in NE Minnesota
- 101,000 acres in size
- Approx. 44,000 acres of wetlands
- All aquatic resources = 47,000+ acres
- Began their Wetland Program in Oct 1998
- Started before EPA Core Elements
- No Wetland Program Plans yet

 - Wetland Program Plan/EPA Wetland Core Elements

KNOW WHAT YOU HAVE

- What Work Has Already Been Accomplished?
 - Lake Assessments/Water Quality Assessments
 - State Wetland Inventory/National Wetland Inventory
 - State Biological Inventory/Plant Inventory
 - State Rare Species (T&E Species) Inventories

KNOW WHAT YOU KNOW

- What Skills Do You Have And What Additional Training Do You Need?
 - Wetland Delineation Wetland Hydrology, Wetland Soils, Wetland Plants
 - Botany/Plant Identification
 - Geographic Information Systems (GIS)/Mapping
 - Wetland Inventory/Cowardin Coding/LLWW Coding
 - TEK (Traditional Ecological Knowledge)
